Eligibility Requirements

Eligible individuals are those who:



➤ Self-identify as a person with a disability



> Are a resident of Ontario



➤ Are eligible to work in Canada, provide SIN and photo ID



- > Are unemployed or currently not in school fulltime*
- * Exceptions can be made in some circumstances







Who is Supported Employment For?

First and foremost, Supported Employment is for Individuals who want to work in competitive employment

- **Competitive employment** is work that is performed and individuals are paid at or above the set minimum wage
- Hours worked can be full time hours, part time hours or even casual
